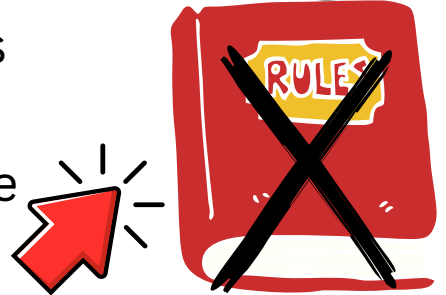

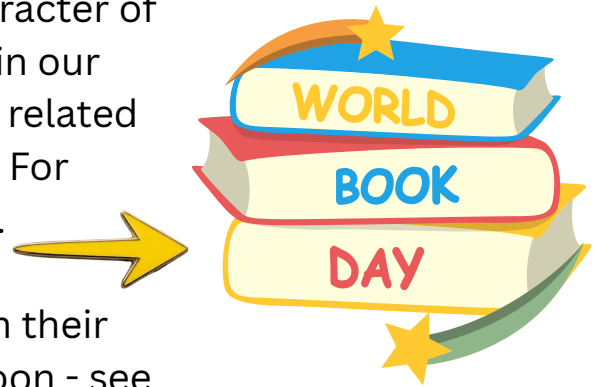


Break the Rules Day is coming to Hobletts Manor Schools next Friday 13th February! Raising funds for school resources - please refer to the poster below or clicking here

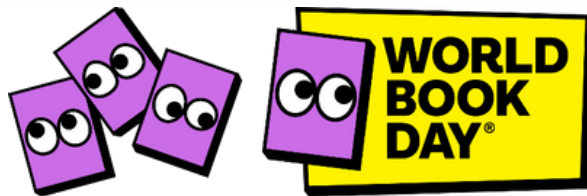
