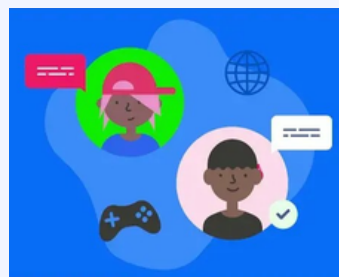
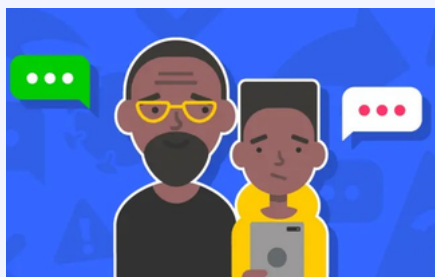
A Focus On .. Keeping Our Children Safe ..

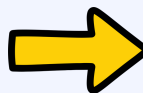
