Many thanks to those who braved the weather to drop their clothing donations on Tuesday as we once again participated in The Little Recyclers school fundraising programme.

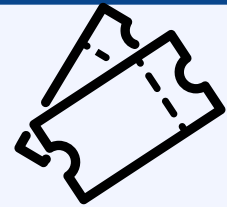
Not only have we helped to divert textile waste ending up in landfills, but we have also raised an additional £36.00 for the Hobletts schools.

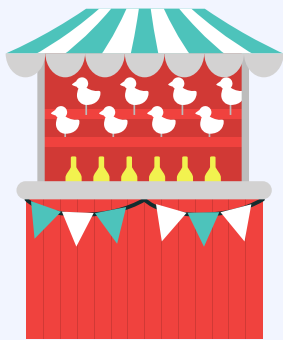
## Times Table Rockstars
