As you are aware, we received a visit last week from our School Effectiveness Advisor (SEA). Our chosen focus was behaviour and time was spent talking to myself, Mrs C Short (INCo), Mrs Helena Marks-Dwyer (SEND and Wellbeing governor) and pupils across the school. Observations of morning transitions and visits to classrooms also formed part of the visit.

We are proud to share the key outcomes of the visit with you :



A key strength of the school is the proactive and personalised support provided to pupils, particularly at the start of the school day, which enables them to feel safe, settled and ready to learn.



The school has established effective systems and targeted support to meet the needs of pupils with additional needs. Strong relationships between staff and pupils underpin this work and contribute to a calm and supportive school environment.



Leadership of inclusion remains highly effective, with thorough identification of need and well planned interventions having a positive impact on pupils' well-being and engagement. The InCo is thorough and demonstrates an excellent understanding of pupils and their individual needs.



Behaviour was calm and purposeful and relationships between staff and pupils were positive.



All pupils said that learning was 'fun' and that they liked coming to school. They reported that adults were supportive and helped them with their learning.

Pupils talked positively about breaktimes, lunchtimes, friendship groups and the activities they enjoyed at school.

We look to continue our work with our SEA next year as we look to further enhance provision and build upon our strengths.
